


PCCTF – Vision Committee Statement




Why invest in activation?

This can can address the lagging economic recovery from the pandemic and other causes.



Activation Programming

Who? Travel Oregon, Travel Portland, Prosper Portland, and potential philanthropic donors

What? Grants for sustained programming, incentives, and events. Longer programmatic support (3 to 5 years) provides stability for organizations and the ability to coordinate.

When? ASAP, starting in 2024

Where? All nine neighborhoods in Central City

Why? Drive out-of-town visitors to Central City and increase room nights through

Example activation investments

- Expand programming/events with a recent positive track record
- Amplify programming of Central City cultural and arts organizations, especially in the public realm
- Invest in new programming that meet RCTP goals
- Bring back events with a successful track record of drawing visitors but lack funding
- Implement incentives for hotel visitors
